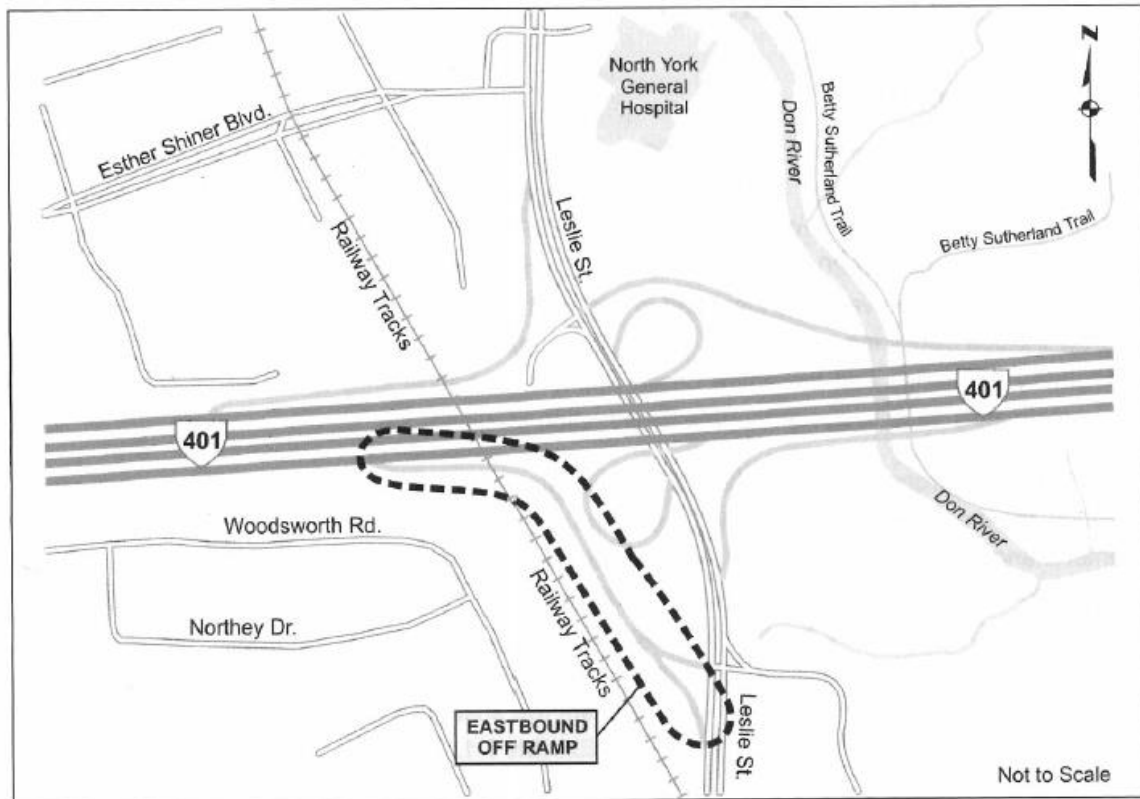


**NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION
REALIGNMENT OF THE EASTBOUND OFF-RAMP
HIGHWAY 401 / LESLIE STREET
CONTRACT NO. 2016-2048
CITY OF TORONTO**



The Ministry of Transportation (MTO) is undertaking the re-alignment of the eastbound off-ramp at the Highway 401 and Leslie Street Interchange. As part of the re-alignment, construction activities will also include replacement of the Metrolinx pedestrian bridge; upgrading of traffic signals at the W-N/S ramp terminal intersection; and replacement of the noise barrier where impacted by construction.

In order to ensure the safety and mobility of travelling public, pedestrians, GO Transit commuters and the safety of workers, there is the potential of short-term lane closures to accommodate construction activities, i.e., intersection work at Leslie Street. Advanced signage will be placed to inform motorists of upcoming closures. During construction, traffic will continue to exit Highway 401 at Leslie Street using either the existing ramp or a detour ramp.

The pedestrian bridge that provides access to the Oriole GO Station will be replaced during construction and may have a small number of short-term closures for specific construction work. Advanced notifications about the closures will be posted at the Oriole GO Station and at the pedestrian bridge by GO Transit/Metrolinx.

As a result of construction activities, there may be construction noise which may affect your residence for a short duration.
